	<u>DEFINITION AND CATEGORIES OF SPORTS FACILITIES</u>
	<u>CATEGORY A</u>
	Stadium
	National facility should be able to host National level competitions and tournaments, and depending on International Governing Body specifications, also host international events.
	<u>CATEGORY B</u>
	Community Stadiums
	Hosts community sport events including school tournaments and competitive sport
	<u>CATEGORY C</u>
	Sport Complex
	Multi sport facility that can host multiple activities. It is usually fenced and may consist of several courts, playing field/s, club house and ablution blocks.
	<u>CATEGORY D</u>
	Indoor sport facility/Arena
	The indoor facilities must also be multi-use, and provide reasonable seating, and a play surface that is appropriate for multiple activities and marked accordingly. The playing area should have a minimum clearance of 2 metres on all sides. The facility must have male and female ablutions with at least one
	<u>CATEGORY E1</u>
	Single use outdoor facilities
	Facilities meant for a specific code such as golf, cricket and so on. Such facilities are fenced, have a clubhouse and a playing field.
	<u>CATEGORY E2</u>
	Stand alone
	Netball courts, tennis courts and basketball courts which may be fenced with/without ablution facilities
	<u>CATEGORY F</u>
	Open fields
	Grassed / Non-grassed fields. Most instances managed by Clubs / LFAs
