In terms of Section 93F (1) and (2) of the Municipal Systems Act, the following persons shall not be eligible for consideration as a Director of a Municipal Entity:

- a) A person holding office as a Councilor of any Municipality.
- b) A person who is a member of the National Assembly or a Provincial Legislature.
- c) A person who is a permanent delegate to the National Council of Provinces.
- d) A person who is an official of the parent Municipality of that Municipal Entity.
- e) A person who was convicted of any offense and sentenced to imprisonment without the option of a fine, and a period of five years since completion of the sentence has not lapsed.
- f) A person who has been declared by a court to be of unsound mind; or
- g) A person who is an un-rehabilitated insolvent.

Applicants are required to submit an application letter, a detailed CV, and a certified copy of ID, on or before the 19th of February 2023.
